

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR CHAPTER AWARD WINNERS!!!!

Phi Chi Theta supports an environment where member and chapter participation is recognized and superior performance is rewarded. Congratulations to our 2017-2018 and biennium award recipients.

CHAPTER GROWTH AWARD

This award is presented annually to a Chapter in each Region that has shown the greatest percentage increase in membership for the year based on membership and initiation reports submitted to the National Office. The winners were presented with a certificate from the National Office and a monetary award.

Central Region – **Alpha Upsilon** – 27.3%

Western Region – **Zeta Pi** – 48.5%

Eastern Region – **Zeta Zeta**– 285.7%

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AWARD

This award is presented to one chapter nationwide annually that exemplifies the spirit of communication and cooperation. This chapter has honored all deadlines set forth in the Calendar of Due Dates and has done an exceptional job in communicating with the National Office. The winner is selected by the Executive Director and will be presented with a certificate from the National Office and a monetary award.

CHAPTER PERFORMANCE AWARDS

Points are awarded from items completed on the Calendar of Due Dates. The items must be completed and submitted to the National Office by the deadline posted on the calendar in order to receive the points. There are base points and the chapters can also earn bonus points in each category. This point system allows the National Office to rate the efficiency of our chapters and it infuses a healthy spirit of competition between our chapters.

The Awards presented at the 2018 National Meeting were based on a chapter performance from 2017-2018. Top chapters in each region were given special recognition.

Annual awards include the “Fraternity Spirit & Cooperation Award”, “Business Ideals Award”, “Financial Management Award” and the “Membership Recruitment & Development Award”.

“FRATERNITY SPIRIT & COOPERATION AWARD”

Points were awarded for submitting documents such as the National & Regional Meeting Reports, Founders’ Day Report, Professional Development Report, National Make a Difference Day Report, submitting IRIS articles and for good communication skills with their Regional Director.

Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (160) and Alumni (120).

Chapters receiving special recognition in this category are:

- Central Region – Epsilon Gamma (160)
- Eastern Region – Alpha Mu (178), Zeta Nu (196), Alpha Iota & Alpha Omega (197) 2-way tie

The chapter with the highest number of points in this category received the Excellence Award. They are:

- Eastern Region – Beta Chi (199)
- Central Region – Zeta Eta (200)
- Western Region – Denver Alumni (180)

“BUSINESS IDEALS AWARD”

Points are awarded for submitting documents such as the chapter officer list, membership list, calendar, graduate lists, updated Bylaws and conducting officer training.

Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (220) and Alumni (120).

Chapters receiving special recognition in this category are:

- Central Region – Epsilon Gamma (220) and Epsilon Phi (240)

The chapter with the highest number of points in this category received the Excellence Award. They are:

- Eastern Region – Alpha Iota, Alpha Mu, Alpha Omega, Beta Chi & Zeta Nu (260) 5-way tie
- Central Region – Zeta Eta (250)
- Western Region – Zeta Omicron (260)
- Western Region – Denver Alumni Chapter (150)

“FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AWARD”

Points are awarded for paying fees on time, submitting an annual budget, conducting an annual audit and making a contribution to the Foundation.

Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (140) and Alumni (140).

Chapters receiving special recognition in this category are:

- Eastern Region – Alpha Iota, Alpha Mu, Alpha Omega & Zeta Nu (150) 4-way tie

The chapter with the highest number of points in this category received the Excellence Award.

They are:

- Western Region – Zeta Omicron (150)
- Central Region – Epsilon Gamma, Epsilon Phi & Zeta Eta (150) 3-way tie
- Eastern Region – Beta Chi (190)
- Western Region – Denver Alumni Chapter (190)

“MEMBERSHIP RECRUITMENT & DEVELOPMENT AWARD”

Points are awarded for holding RUSH each semester, submitting pledge & initiation lists, applying for scholarships and holding alumni activities.

Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (160) and Alumni (80).

Chapters receiving special recognition in this category are:

- Eastern Region – Zeta, Delta Sigma & Zeta Lambda (160) 3-way tie; Alpha Iota, Alpha Omega (180) 2-way tie; Beta Chi (190) & Zeta Nu (200)
- Central Region – Zeta Gamma (160) & Zeta Xi (170)

The chapter with the highest number of points in this category received the Excellence Award.

They are:

- Western Region – Zeta Omicron (170)
- Central Region – Epsilon Gamma, Epsilon Phi & Zeta Eta (180) 3-way-tie
- Eastern Region – Alpha Mu (220)

2016-2018 BIENNIUM AWARDS

Biennium Awards are the combined award points from the biennium (2014-2016). If the chapter achieves 85% of the minimum points for the two years, they receive recognition in the respective categories:

“Candle of Knowledge Award” – Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (1156) and Alumni (850):

- Eastern Region – Zeta Kappa (1180), New York Beta (1197), Zeta Nu (1308) & Zeta (1333)
- Central Region – Delta Xi (1160), Alpha Upsilon (1250) & Zeta Epsilon (1295)
- Western Region – Delta Chi (1156) & Beta Theta (1260)

“Ship of Achievement Award” – Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (1360) and Alumni (1000):

- Eastern Region – Alpha Mu (1375), Alpha Iota (1417) & Alpha Omega (1553)
- Central Region – Zeta Xi (1400), Epsilon Gamma (1485), Epsilon Phi (1500) & Zeta Eta (1510)
- Western Region – Zeta Omicron (1470)
- Western Region – Denver Alumni Chapter (1065)

“Chapter Aspiration Award” – Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (1581) and Alumni (1241):

- Eastern Region – Beta Chi (1638)

“Phi Chi Theta Chapter of Excellence Award” – Minimum points for recognition in this category: Collegiate (1860) and Alumni (1460):

NATIONAL KEY AWARD

The Phi Chi Theta National Key Award recipient is selected at every National Chapter Meeting on the basis of the nominee’s contributions to the local Phi Chi Theta chapter; collegiate, civic, and career achievements while attaining his/her baccalaureate (or masters) degree. The nominee must be a recipient of their local chapter’s Key Award. Nominations may be made by any chapter. The selection is made by a committee appointed by the National President. The winner was presented with an award from the National Office.

This award is presented to any individual member in recognition of outstanding service to Phi Chi Theta. The service can be rendered at the local, regional or national level.
