Using Virtual Meeting Apps:

1. Host a Lip Sync Battle
2. Play Charades
3. Host a Talent Show, take a hand count for voting on the winners
4. Have a competition for best background
5. Have a show and tell
6. Pictionary on the whiteboard plugins
7. Host an exercise activity such as Zumba, Yoga

Use Discord and STEAM to create rooms and have game nights

ALUMNI EVENTS

1. Host a virtual networking mixer - use “rooms” to have breakout sessions based on industry or company
2. Ask Alumni to give members a virtual tour of their employing companies
3. Have Alumni speakers at virtual meetings for different business or career-related topics
4. Gather an Alumni panel for advice and questions from members
5. Use one of the suggested social events (such as pictionary or rap battle) for some friendly competition with teams set up for collegiates versus alumni
